



**1. East African Development Assoc.**  
**7. Masjid Al-Huda**  
 4735 NW Radial Hwy

A non-profit organization that provides support and community to newly-arrived people mainly from East Africa. The building also houses Masjid Al-Huda, where Muslims come to pray daily. The women and men have their own section. There is a barrier between the areas and people have to do Wudu; washing body parts such as the face, arms and the feet.



**2. Lutheran Family Services**

An aid agency that focuses on safely integrating refugees into their new homes.



**3. Somali Independence Day @ Bob Kerry Bridge**  
 705 Riverfront Dr

On July 1st Somalis celebrate their independence on the bridge. They bring food and listen to Somali music as well as perform traditional dances.



**4. Somali American Heritage Society**

The Somali American Heritage Society of NE is a non-profit that seeks to promote the well-being of Somali immigrants in Nebraska.



**5. Fiserv**  
 6855 Pacific St

A common, long-term job in the financial industry that is available to refugees.



**6. Tyson Foods**  
 13076 Renfro Cir

Tyson Meat Plant offers many jobs to incoming refugees. Several Somalis described Tyson as their first job opportunity.



**8. Millard Islamic Foundation**  
 5135 Marshall Dr

This is a mosque where people come to pray their five daily prayers.

**12. Tri-Faith Initiative**  
 13140 Faith Plaza

This place promotes Islamic teachings to the Western world. Non-Muslim and Muslims come here to learn about Islam. Also here is the Tri-Faith Initiative, a place inspiring interfaith relationships by bringing together Christian, Jewish, and Muslim communities.



**10. Islamic Center of Omaha**

This is a non-profit organization where Islamic teachings are offered. They teach the Quran and Arabic as well.



**11. Shafie Islamic Center**

 3215 Cuming St


An educational center that provides English learning classes to refugees.
