⇒ ATTENDANCE MATTERS ⇐

That's right, school attendance does matter throughout the entire OPS district and at Hartman! Once again, all Hartman Hawks are STRIVING FOR 95! for the 2022-2023 school year. To 'hit' that 95% attendance rate, students can miss no more than 9 days of school. Remember, minutes missed in the am, during the day and/or at the end of the day can quickly add up. Here are some important facts regarding school attendance: ♦ being late to school may lead to poor attendance ♦ students who miss too much school in PK and K are less likely to be reading by 3rd grade ♦ starting in kindergarten, too many absences can cause children to fall behind in school ♦ by 6th grade, absenteeism is one of three signs that a student may drop out of high school ♦ by 9th grade, regular and high attendance is a better predictor of graduation rates than 8th grade test scores ♦ students who miss less than 9 days of school each year are more likely to stay engaged, be successful and on-track for graduation.
